ORDINANCE NO. C-30

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWTON AS FOLLOWS:

That the Revised Ordinances of Newton, Massachusetts, 2017, as amended, be and are hereby further amended with respect to ARTICLE I PUBLIC BUILDINGS DEPARTMENT of Chapter 5 as follows:

1. **INSERT** the following new **Section 5-4. Application of second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides by the City:**

(a) For the purposes of this Section 5-4, the following words shall be defined as follows:

*Second-Generation Anticagulant Rodenticides:* A rodenticide that was developed to control rodents that are resistant to first-generation anticoagulants, including but not limited to brodifacoum, bromadiolone, difenacoum, and difethialone.

(b) The City shall not utilize Second-Generation Anticoagulant Rodenticides for any rodent control activities undertaken by the City.


