


### Version 2.0 Village Center Zoning Maps Shared at April 24 ZAP Meeting

At the April 24th Zoning and Planning Committee (ZAP) meeting, Planning staff and consultant, Utile, presented the updated <u>Version 2.0</u> Village Center Zoning Maps. The maps reflect feedback received from both the public and ZAP workshops on the first version. They also, if adopted, would bring Newton into compliance with the MBTA Communities Law.
