Public Hearing on VCOD Zoning Opened on June 26

On June 26 the Zoning and Planning Committee (ZAP) opened the public hearing on the <u>Version 2.0 Village Center Overlay District (VCOD) zoning proposal</u> Over 600 participants (500 on Zoom and 100 in-person) were present for the discussion.
