RE: Approval of Marijuana Dispensary Adjacent to Happy Child Daycare

Dear Neil:

This firm represents Happy Child Daycare Center, Inc. ("Happy Child"), located at 1191 Chestnut Street, Newton, MA. It has recently come to our attention that the City Council is considering the approval of a marijuana dispensary in the immediate vicinity of Happy Child. In accordance with the Code of Massachusetts Regulations and Newton's own ordinances, we urge you to deny the permit of the marijuana dispensary for this location.

The Code of Massachusetts Regulations ("CMR") requires marijuana dispensaries to have a buffer zone of five hundred feet between the center of a Marijuana Establishment Entrance and a School Entrance. See 936 CMR 500.110(3)(a). A "School Entrance" is defined as "the entrance(s) that provide ingress and egress to students of the preexisting public or private school providing education in kindergarten or any grades 1 through 12 at the time of the newspaper publication of the proposed Marijuana Establishment's community outreach meeting under 935 CMR 500.101(1)(a)9.a." See 935 CMR 500.002. The CMR gives the city discretion in reducing the buffer zone by ordinance. See 935 CMR 500.110(3)(b).

Under Newton's Ordinances, a Registered Marijuana Dispensary ("RMD") may not be located within a five-hundred-foot radius of a school, daycare center, or preschool. See Newton Ordinance, ch. 30 § 6.10.3(E). Confusingly, the ordinance then states the same radius applies for Marijuana Retailers, who sell to a broader customer base, but the buffer zone applies to existing public or private K-12 schools. See Newton Ordinance, ch. 30 § 6.10.3(E).

Happy Child offers preschool and kindergarten to many parents in Newton. As a kindergarten school, Happy Child is entitled under the CMR and Newton's ordinances to a five-hundred-foot buffer zone between it and any marijuana dispensary, which the current plan would

not provide. Further, it is unthinkable that the City Council would see it fit to include a buffer zone between marijuana establishments and preschools, but not include a buffer zone with Marijuana Retailers, who sell to a much larger customer base. We ask that you uphold the ordinances of Newton by denying the permit of the marijuana dispensary.
