Dear City Council Members,

Thanks for the work you do in keeping Newton safe for all of us.

I am a 36 year resident of Newtonville right around the corner from the proposed build on 120 Norwood and directly abutting the property.

- We are fine with the demolition of the existing home, we are <u>vehemently</u> opposed to putting four townhouses (instead of the allowed two dwellings) in two buildings squeezed into this lot, adding a minimum of eight cars to an existing traffic nightmare.
- We have a serious traffic issue <u>now</u>. Teachers and commuter rail travelers already park on our streets. Daily drop of/pick up of children to school, aftercare programs and sports make streets impassable.
- Norwood, Bridge and Clarendon Streets experience <u>daily</u> serious hazards to children, all pedestrians, bike riders and vehicles due to regularly blocked driveways, illegal parking, three-point turns in the middle of the street, high speeds, running the stop sign and narrow passages. These have been documented with pictures and videos.
- Emergency vehicles, utility vehicles, fire trucks all risk blockage by narrow passages
- A new development adding a minimum of eight more cars daily is pushing us to the edge. This dreadful traffic situation is the case <u>now</u>.

<u>Please</u> help us by holding the developer to the allowed two dwellings on this plot of land.
