In 1984 Congress recognized the vital role that television would have in people's lives... and that diverse, local voices would get lost in programming created by national companies.

So they mandated that in return for using the public right of way (telephone poles, conduits, & sidewalks), cable companies had to pay a franchise fee to fund local Access Stations.

These days some people still watch traditional cable tv, which continues to fund Access Stations.
