Village Center Zoning Efforts Continue with ZAP Meetings & Public Hearing

ZAP Refinements to the Village Center Zoning Proposal

On August 15th and 21st, the Zoning and Planning Committee (ZAP) met to discuss the village center zoning, referred to as the Village Center Overlay District (VCOD), and continued working towards a Version 3.0 zoningmap and text amendments. These changes include the removal of the Village Center 1 overlay district and increased protections for abutting residential districts through VCOD building stepdown and greater setback requirements.

Upcoming ZAP Meetings in September

There are three ZAP meetings happening this month. At the first two meetings on September 7th and 11th the Committee will continue to vote on proposed VCOD map amendments. These meetings will be held in person in room 204 and on Zoom.
