Sec. 19-174 (b) *Other Vehicles:* From December 1st-January 1 through March 31<sup>st</sup> March 1 it shall be unlawful for any vehicle, other than one acting in an emergency, to be parked on any street, way, highway, road parkway, or private way dedicated or open to the use of the public for a period of time longer than one hour between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
