#283-03      HIS HONOR THE MAYOR requesting an appropriation in the amount of \$259,283.79 from the RCN Gift Fund, to be expended through the Planning Department in the form of a grant to the Newton Communications Access Center (NCAC), Inc. for the promotion of public, educational, and governmental access programming and for other cable-related purposes and for capital acquisition.

#285-03      COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE recommending that the sum of \$99,931 be appropriated from Community Preservation Unreserved Funds for the purpose of funding costs for creating the Albemarle Community Classroom/Park.
