# 70386

Exhibition on themes of survival at a Cambridge Gallery through three different exhibitions/artists, one from Newton. Request is for \$4,350. Robert does not recommend due to impact on Newton. Unanimously declined.

#### 69635

Boston Festival of New Jewish Music requesting support for a Klezmer Community Dance party in Newton Highlands. Request is for \$2k of \$3200 budget, Robert recommends. Eight in favor.

### 61812

Visual Arts. Request for a stone carving symposium at a center in Acton in the amount of \$800 of \$10,000 budget. No significant benefit to Newton. Unanimously declined.

### 57044

Healing Art Journal. This is a request for a workshop and Zoom meeting. Serves an important function, but not aligned with highest priorities. Request is for \$1400 of \$10k budget. 1 in favor, 8 against.

### 69805

Music- Aspiring voices in Jewish Music. Discussion about whether this is for the congregation and open to the public. Robert should ask also about how they are marketing.

#### 57590

Music from the Margins—East West. Will take place at the Allen House. Unanimously accepted.

#### 59885

Henna Diaries. The project is to create a body of work. There is no confirmed venue or date. Unanimously declined.

#### 68990

Live Music Making History Live. No confirmed venue. Budget \$300 asking for \$300 and no Newton connection.

Latin Jazz. Requesting 1400 of 3120 budget. Chris is lukewarm. Youtubes are uninspiring. Paula attended one of their concerts and felt that the project is of quality. All in favor.
