To be eligible for nomination, entrants must have made a significant contribution to the promotion and protection of human rights in Newton and been active in this non-professional area for several years. Examples could include:

- · taking action to overcome discrimination or infringements of human rights within Newton
- encouraging greater social harmony in a range of areas such as race relations, gender equality and the treatment of children and young people
- enhancing the rights of a specific population
- promoting equal opportunity for people with a disability or countering discrimination on the basis of age or sexuality
- increasing awareness of issues of injustice or inequality

- Attach relevant supporting documentation (if applicable).

- You can enclose up to three letters of support (this is optional and should be up to 5 pages).
