#13-24 Request to further extend nonconforming FAR at 140 Dickerman Road

MARTINE MARTELL petition for SPECIAL PERMIT/SITE PLAN APPROVAL to enclose a second level sunporch and construct a new basement access, further extending the nonconforming FAR at 140 Dickerman Road, Ward 5, Newton Highlands, on land known as Section 54 Block 38 Lot 12, containing approximately 6,600 sq. ft. of land in a district zoned SINGLE RESIDENCE 2. Ref: Sec. 7.3.3, 3.1.3, 3.1.9, 7.8.2.C.2 of Chapter 30 of the City of Newton Rev Zoning Ord, 2017.

Action: Land Use Approved 7-0; Public Hearing Closed 7-0

Note: Joe ladonisi, Senior Planner presented the request to covert the porch to a living space and to construct a new basement access further extending nonconforming FAR at 140 Dickerman Road. Lee Dearborn, principal designer and general contractor explained the work that would be done at the property. This work will conceal the bulkhead to the basement from the back yard.

The public hearing was opened, and no members of the public spoke about this item.

A councilor asked if there would be changes to the impervious surface. Mr. Deaborn noted there would be no change.

Councilors expressed support for the project.

The public hearing was closed.

The committee reviewed the draft Council order and Councilor Downs motioned to approve which passed unanimously.
