### **5-58 for the Horace Mann School Building at 225 Nevada Street**

DESIGN REVIEW COMMITTEE petition, pursuant to 5-58, for schematic design and site plan approval at 225 Nevada Street to construct a new 22,000 SF addition to be located directly behind and adjacent to the existing gymnasium. The new addition will allow for additional educational space and grade-level clustering of classrooms with additional educational support spaces, an enlarged cafetorium, and music room. The project will include interior renovations to adjust some existing classroom and educational room sizes and provide a new library space. When completed the school facility will provide a total of 18 general education classrooms, Break-out and/or Project Areas for each grade level, improved special education spaces and will accommodate a design enrolment of 396 to 414 students
