Crafts St: From Albermarle Rd to Walnut St {both sides}

Edinboro St: Odd side

Eliot Ave: Both sides 50ft back from Watertown St & Even side

Fair Oaks Ave: Odd side

Fairway Drive: Both sides 50ft back from Watertown St & Even side

Farwell St: Even side

Fessenden St: Odd side

Kensington St: Both sides 50ft back from Watertown St & Odd side

Minot Place: Both sides

Morrill St: From Crafts St to Fuller Ave {Even side}

Nevada St: 100 Ft from the intersection of Albermarle Rd {both sides}

Pleasant St: From Waltham St to Lyme Rd {Even side}

Randlett Park: Both sides 50ft back from Watertown St & Odd side

Proctor St: Even side

Rossmore St: Odd side

Scotfield Drive: Odd side

Walker St: Even side

Warwick Rd: Even side

Wildwood Ave: Both sides 50ft back from Watertown St & Even side

Road Closed: July 4, 2024 5:00pm to 11:00pm

Albermarle Rd: From Watertown to Crafts St {Both sides}

Albermarle Rd {southbound} @ North St

Crafts St: From Waltham St to California St

Edinboro St

Minot Place

North St: From Albermarle Rd (northbound) to Crafts St

Under Chapter 19 section 47: We are adding 4 handicap spaces.

2 spaces at the carnival near the Newton Early Childhood School

2 spaces at the Gath Pool
