Applications

150 Woodland Road - Certificate of Appropriateness

HISTORIC SIGNIFICANCE: The Colonial Revival/Shingle style house was built circa 1892 by Boston businessman Albert Van Wagenen for his daughter and son-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Howard P. Converse. Howard Converse was a construction engineer noted for the building of Commonwealth Pier in Boston. Lasell Junior College purchased the house in 1959 for use as a dormitory.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Lasell University wants to install heat pumps at the back of the building. They have planted evergreens along the path to the basement door as screening.

Note: The applicants were asked to investigate whether the pumps could be moved so as not to block the basement windows and if any of them could be located under the back entry area.
