Newton Cable License Renewal Public Hearing

Newton Mayor Ruthanne Fuller, as statutory cable television license Issuing Authority, has designated a Newton Law Department hearing officer to hold a public cable license renewal hearing on **December 10, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.** at Room 204, City Hall, 1000 Commonwealth Ave., Newton Center, Newton to allow public comment on public and City cable needs as part of the City's license renewal proceedings pertaining to Comcast Cable Communications, Inc. ("Comcast") and Verizon New England, Inc. ("Verizon"), respectively. The Newton Comcast cable license expires on June 30, 2027. The Newton Verizon cable license expires on June 30, 2027. The federal Cable Act, 47 USC 546, requires a public renewal proceeding to ascertain the community's cable needs and interests. Public comment is invited regarding license renewal needs and cable operator past performance. The hearing officer will accept comments relating to the foregoing subject to the Mayor's reserving control of any and all license-related decisions.
