AP7-24 <u>DONNA MESSINGER</u>, requesting an accessible parking space in front of 147 Arnold Road. (Ward 8) [10/10/24 @ 3:31 PM]

TC18-24 <u>VLADAN AND TAMMY JOVANOVIC</u>, 276 Greenwood Street, requesting a 4-way stop at the intersection of Greenwood Street and Arnold Road. (Ward 8) [05/13/24 @ 11:27 AM]

TC45-24 <u>LASELL UNIVERSITY AND COUNCILOR GENTILE</u>, requesting to add Studio Road into the Auburndale Village Parking District, with parking to be by permit only within the areas where parking will be allowed. (Ward 4) [10/22/24 @ 8:42 AM]
