#143-16 Funding to supplement DPW accounts for snow and ice removal

Action: Public Facilities Approved 4-0 (Lennon, Laredo not voting)

**Note:** Commissioner of Public Works Jim McGonagle presented the request for funds to supplement the department's snow and ice removal accounts. There were two unanticipated snow events in April. As a result, the City spent \$3,597,486 on snow and ice operations this season. Commissioner McGonagle confirmed that the magnesium chloride brine that was used this year worked well to combat ice bonding with the pavement and assist ice and snow removal. Commissioner McGonagle noted that the brine is more environmentally friendly. The Committee had questions about the cost effectiveness of using the brine. Commissioner McGonagle stated that he can get the salt/brine comparison figures for the Committee.

Councilor Lappin moved for approval which carried 4-0.
