27-03 <u>ALD. SALVUCCI, SCHNIPPER, LINSKY, STEWART, LAPPIN AND YATES</u> requesting a review of all change orders to date with Public Buildings Commissioner and the Project Manager on the Newton South High School project.

ACTION: HELD 7-0

NOTE: Mike Rourke and Nick Parnell were present for discussion of this item. Dick Ampster (Turner Construction), Carl Franceschi (Drummey Rosane Anderson, Inc.) and Mike Burton (Turner Construction) were also present. Mr. Rourke explained that a lot of time has been spent with the School Committee, the project manager and the architects on this project. He feels that the first stage of the project has been done very well. The project is going ahead hopefully within budget and on time.

> Mr. Parnell has provided the Finance and Public Facilities Committees with monthly reports with change orders attached. Unfortunately, change orders for Phase IA were not provided at the meeting. The Committee requested that Mr. Parnell provide them in the next packet. The Committee reviewed each of the change orders to date on Phase IB of the project. DRA, the Commissioner and the Mayor evaluated all of the change orders.

The Committee would like more detailed reports from Commissioner Parnell regarding the progress of the project and change orders. Commissioner Parnell agreed to alert the Committee of any changes to the project. It was decided to have frequent reviews of the project during Committee meetings. Ald. Lappin moved hold, which the Committee voted unanimously.
