**NOTE:** Commissioner Parnell provided the Committee with photos of the ongoing Newton South renovations and construction. He has been giving the Committee updates and current change orders for Newton South every month. The project is moving along. Mello Construction is doing their site work and the classroom addition is complete. Peabody Construction is working diligently on renovating two classroom wings. Commissioner Parnell would like to give a PowerPoint presentation to the Committee every month or every other month showing slides of all the construction activity that is occurring.

> The Committee had a brief discussion surrounding the cuts to the project and change orders. There is concern about the change orders and the fact that they are a result of design flaws. It was the Committee's understanding that when a project manager was hired it would give the City some oversight and protection. Commissioner Parnell would like Dick Ampster, project manager, and Carl Franchesci, architect; to join the Committee to discuss the change orders and design flaws. Ald. Lappin made a motion to hold the item until June when the architect and project manager will be available to discuss the item with the Committee. In addition, Commissioner Parnell will give a PowerPoint presentation. The Committee voted unanimously to hold the item.
