All public bodies consisting of more than one member shall provide for a period of public comment at reasonable intervals, but in any case, at least once per calendar year. Where notice of a public meeting is posted in accordance with the open meeting law, and where said public body expects to allow for a period of public comment, the public body must post a specific time at which public comment will be accepted. This does not prevent a public body from allowing unanticipated public comment at any time.

Option 1: Where notice is provided for a public comment period, the public body must make best efforts to accommodate public comment at the noticed time.

Option 2: Where notice is provided for a public comment period, the public body may alter the time at which public comment will take place by announcing the new public comment time at any time during the meeting.
