 - b. Fiscal 2009 School Budget
 - c. Gibson Report on Management Structure in the NPS
 - d. HRS Compensation and Classification Study
 - e. Contract with Newton Teachers Association
 - f. SPED Enrollment Data
 - g. Department of Education '07 per pupil expenditures in Newton
- 2. Interview both the Chair of the School Committee and the Superintendent in order to gain their help in developing a list of pertinent school officials and school committee members who could inform our study groups
- 3. Engage those school officials, school committee members, parents, and others who work closely with education in the city in conversations about their observations of school operations
- 4. Seek out and utilize benchmarks utilizing two sets of comparisons:
