Mr. Koses, Mr. Prizant and Ms. Freedman provided PowerPoint presentations, attached to this report.

AP3-19 <u>COUNCILOR NOEL</u>, requesting to make the temporary accessible parking space

at 18-20 Coyne Road into a permanent accessible parking space. (Ward 5)

[06/03/19 @ 10:35 AM]

The Commission on Disability Approved 10-0 on July 8, 2019.

**ACTION:** APPROVED 4-0, Ciccone not voting. Approved the language of TPR 494.

TPR 494 adds an accessible parking space at 18-20 Coyne Road.

This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location map and background information.

Mr. Koses stated that the Commission on Disability approved this request unanimously. A temporary accessible parking space was installed in 2019 during construction of an adjacent home. This request is to make the accessible parking space permanent.

Mr. Koses opened the discussion to members of the public who were present. There was no public comment.

Without discussion, Mr. Koses made the motion to approve this item. Council members agreed 4-0, Councilor Ciccone not voting. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.

TC27-19 <u>COUNCILORS KELLEY, COTE AND BROUSAL-GLASER</u>, requesting to

discuss and possibly implement a change to the parking regulations on Noble

Street. (Ward 3) [05-16-19 @ 4:12 PM]

**ACTION:** NO ACTION NECESSARY 5-0.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location map and street characteristics.

Mr. Koses stated that Noble Street is a typical Newton street with a width of 24 feet. There are no current parking restrictions. Parking observations on five occasions showed that between one to six vehicles are parking on Noble Street. The utility poles are located on the east side, fire hydrants on the west side.

Mr. Koses provided Council members with several options for consideration including a vote of no action necessary or to add a parking regulation on one side of Noble Street as a trial or vote to make it a permanent change.

Mr. Koses briefly described the seven emails received in opposition to this request. These emails are on file.

Councilor Kelley stated that he was surprised to hear residents are opposed to this request. The residents of #14-16 Noble Street are restricted when they try to back out of their driveway, due to vehicles parked opposite the driveway. Councilor Kelley stated that she is requesting 'no parking between signs' at this location hoping to solve the problem. This has been done with success on Derby Street. She then stated that she is not requesting to possibly implement a change to the parking regulations on Noble Street.

Mr. Koses opened the discussion to members of the public who were present. The residents of #14-16 Noble Street stated that it is difficult to back out of their driveway when vehicles are parked opposite and due to the location of the telephone pole. These residents request 'no parking between signs' at this location hoping to enter and exit their driveway without difficulty.

A resident stated that they understand a parking prohibition, all days, east side is being proposed. A resident asked whether written information regarding parking is available to distribute to the neighbors.

Mr. Koses stated that residents on a 24 foot road or less, often request a one side parking prohibition to allow for trash pickup and emergency vehicle access without difficulty. In this case, it appears residents of Noble Street are opposed to a parking restriction. He then noted that he does not recall a situation where parking was restricted opposite one particular driveway to allow residents to enter and exit without difficulty. If Traffic Council approves a request of 'no parking between signs', other residents in the City are likely to request the same. Councilor Kelley asked how to address this concern city-wide for consistency purposes. She asked if the City would remove the existing 'no parking between signs'? She reiterated that she is requesting 'no parking between signs' at this location.

Captain Anastasia stated that it is clear the residents are opposed to a parking restriction. Mr. Prizant stated that if parking is removed it will certainly impact the residents.

Without further discussion, Captain Anastasia made the motion for no action necessary. Council members agreed 5-0.

TC40-19 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, requesting to make a change to the Traffic and Parking Regulations for the entire Washington Street corridor to make it simpler and easier to read. This change will make no change to the posted signage in the field. (Wards 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5) [06/19/19 @ 11:44 AM]

ACTION: APPROVED 4-0-1(Ciccone). Approved the language of TPR 495. TPR 495 rewrites the parking regulations in the TPR for the Washington Street corridor. This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location maps and background information.

Mr. Koses stated that this request will not make any changes to the posted signage in the field. This is a housekeeping item. The parking regulations for Washington Street contains duplicates and errors. It will be easier to divide the Washington Street corridor into the following seven sections: Washington Street - east of St. James Street; Washington Street - St. James Street to Church Street; Washington Street - Church Street to Walnut Street; Washington Street - Walnut Street to Chestnut Street; Washington Street - Chestnut Street to Perkins Street; Washington Street - Perkins Street to Beacon Street and Washington Street - Beacon Street to the Wellesley Town Line.

Councilor Ciccone stated that these three miles of roadway is not site specific. Traffic Council should only discuss site specific locations. He asked if this item should be referred to the Public Safety & Transportation Committee and stated that he will ask the City Clerk for clarification.

Without discussion, Mr. Koses made a motion to approve this item. Council members agreed 4-0-1, Councilor Ciccone abstaining. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.

ISAAC PRIZANT, TRANSPORTATION ENGINEER AND NICOLE
FREEDMAN, DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION PLANNING, requesting to modify the parking regulations on Washington Street (Saint James Street to the Boston City Line), in order to facilitate traffic calming and to create bicycle lanes. The amount of parking on the street would be reduced, with parking generally alternating between the north and south side of the street. (Ward 1) [06/19/19 @ 9:50 AM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 496. TPR 496 removes more than half the parking along the section of Washington Street between St. James Street and the Boston City Line.

This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location maps and site photos.

Ms. Freedman explained in detail the goals of this project from her PowerPoint presentation, attached to report. This request is to implement traffic calming on Washington Street in response to requests for reduced speeds, improved safety and enhanced crossings. In May 2019, a public meeting was held supporting this request. Ms. Freedman also spoke with residents of Hunnewell

Avenue and Circle expressing the same concerns and supporting this request.

Ms. Freedman explained that this request is to modify the parking regulations on Washington Street (Saint James Street to the Boston City Line), in order to facilitate traffic calming and to create bicycle lanes. The amount of parking on the street would be reduced, with parking generally alternating between the north and south side of the street. She then stated that existing conditions include undefined wide travel lane, 85<sup>th</sup> % speed are traveling 34 mph, no bike facilities, insufficient crossings and backups approach St. James Street. If approved, the project would be complete using paint and perhaps flex posts. A trial would not be considered due to the cost of paint and if a trial does not work, the cost to grind out the road. The City will explore the use of flex posts to create a pedestrian refuge island at Washington Street and Waverly Avenue. Proposed crosswalk locations are pending design of the ADA compliant ramps at Washington Street and Grasmere Street and at Washington Street and Elmhurst Road. Ms. Freedman stated that this plan is not a reconstruction project. She then stated that Washington Street has a 15 foot travel lane. If the street width can be reduced to 11 feet, speeds will decrease.

Mr. Prizant stated that this plan reflects what was heard at the public meeting. In order to move this plan forward, parking changes must be implemented. Tweaks will be made, if necessary. He explained in detail each block impacted on this section of Washington Street from his PowerPoint presentation, attached to this report.

Mr. Prizant explained that chicanes (horizontal deflections) would be used on Washington Street to calm traffic and reduce the speed of traffic. Drivers are expected to reduce speed to negotiate the lateral displacement in the vehicle path.

Mr. Koses opened the discussion to members of the public who were present. Residents present expressed their concerns and questions.

#### Concerns:

Drivers are not stopping when traveling east at the two yield signs. Residents from the Washington Street and Hibbard Road area said that three homes share a single driveway, they often park on the south side of Washington Street. It is difficult to cross Washington Street with speeding vehicles; drivers use Washington Street as a highway. Rush hour does not appear to be a problem due to traffic congestion; the other times of the day vehicles have the tendency to speed.

#### Questions:

If this new plan is approved, how much parking will be eliminated on Washington Street?

Mr. Prizant answered that approximately half the parking would be eliminated if the new plan is approved. He then suggested perhaps removing one travel lane and implementing one sided parking on the block of Washington Street to the east of St. James Circle.

Councilor Downs stated that drivers have the tendency to speed when coming down the hill on Washington Street. Drivers speed when exiting Hibbard Road. She noticed vehicles queuing in traffic and a high demand for parking. She then stated that she would support eliminating a travel lane and implement parking as traffic calming measures.

Mr. Prizant provided Council members with two draft Traffic and Parking Regulations (TPR) options for consideration on Washington Street, east of St. James Circle to Hunnewell Avenue.

Councilors Downs and Greenberg stated that they support option 2. Mr. Koses said that option 2 is a complete streets approach to slow traffic making the road safer for bicyclists and pedestrians.

Without further discussion, Mr. Prizant made a motion to approve this item (option 2). He then stated that areas with a two-hour parking limit will remain the same. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019. Mr. Prizant then stated if this item is not appealed, he anticipates painting in the fall 2019. If this item is appealed, he anticipates painting in the spring 2020.

TC25-19 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, requesting to add the traffic signal currently located at the intersection of Nonantum Road and Charlesbank Road into the portion of the TPR that lists traffic signals that are owned, operated and maintained by the state. Note that this item will fix an omission in the TPR and will make no change in the field. (Ward 1) [05/09/19 @ 3:54 PM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 497. TPR 497 adds a traffic signal at Nonantum Road and Charlesbank Road into the TPR. This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location map and site photos.

Mr. Koses stated that this item is to add the traffic signal currently located at the intersection of Nonantum Road and Charlesbank Road into the portion of the Traffic and Parking Regulations (TPR) that lists traffic signals that are owned, operated and maintained by the state. This item will fix an omission and will make no change in the field.

Without discussion, Mr. Koses made a motion to approve this request. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.

TC24-19 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, requesting to add a No Right on Red sign on Charlesbank Road, eastbound, onto Nonantum Road. Note that this item will fix an omission in the TPR and will make no change in the field. (Ward 1) [05/09/19 @ 3:54 PM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 498. TPR 498 adds a No Right on Red sign on Charlesbank at Nonantum into the TPR. This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location map and site photos.

Mr. Koses stated that this item is to add a no right on red sign on Charlesbank Road, eastbound, onto Nonantum Road into the portion of the Traffic and Parking Regulations (TPR). This item will fix an omission and will make no change in the field.

Without discussion, Mr. Koses made a motion to approve this request. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.

TC38-19 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, requesting to change the TPR for Fellsmere Road, to indicate that it is one-way from Dolphin Road to Mandalay Road. This item does not change anything in the field and fixes an error in the TPR. (Ward 7) [06/12/19 @ 2:07 PM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 499. TPR 499 changes the TPR to indicate that Fellesmere is one-way from Dolphin to Mandalay. This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location map and site photos.

Mr. Koses stated that this item is to remove Fellsmere Road, from Mandalay Road to Dolphin Street from the portion of the Traffic and Parking Regulations (TPR). This item will fix an error and will make no change in the field.

Without discussion, Councilor Ciccone made a motion to approve this request. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.

TC37-19 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, requesting to change the TPR for Heatherland Road, to indicate that it is one-way from Winchester Street to Upland Avenue. This item does not change anything in the field and fixes an error in the TPR. (Ward 8) [06/12/19 @ 2:07 PM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 500. TPR 500 changes the TPR to indicate that Heatherland is one-way from Winchester to Upland. This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location map and site photos.

Mr. Koses stated that this item is to indicate that Heatherland Road, is a one-way from Winchester Street to Upland Avenue. This item will fix an error in the Traffic and Parking Regulations (TPR) and will make no change in the field.

Without discussion, Mr. Koses made a motion to approve this request. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.

TC36-19 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, requesting to change the TPR for Newland Street to remove it from the list of one-way streets. This item does not change anything in the field and fixes an error in the TPR. (Ward 4) [06/12/19 @ 2:07 PM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 501. TPR 501 changes the TPR to remove Newland Street from the list of one-way streets. This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

**NOTE:** Council members were provided with a location map and site photos.

Mr. Koses stated that this item requests to remove Newland Street from the list of one-way streets. This item will fix an error in the Traffic and Parking Regulations (TPR) and will make no change in the field.

Without discussion, Councilor Ciccone made a motion to approve this request. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.

TC45-19 <u>DAVID KOSES, TRAFFIC COUNCIL CHAIR</u>, requesting to modify Sec. TPR-194. Time limits in municipal off-street parking areas, to detail the number of parking meters by time limit rather than the percentage. This item makes no changes in the field. (Wards 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6) [07/17/19 @ 1:47 PM]

ACTION: APPROVED 5-0. Approved the language of TPR 502. TPR 502 changes the TPR to list the number of parking meters by time limit, rather than the percentage of parking meters by time limit in our City parking lots.

This item may be appealed through the close of business August 14, 2019.

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**NOTE:** Council members were provided with the current (percentage on distribution of time limits) and proposed (number on distribution of time limits) in the municipal off-street parking areas.

Mr. Koses stated that this item requests to modify the Traffic and Parking Regulations in time limits in municipal off-street parking areas, to detail the number of parking meters by time limit rather than the percentage. This item makes no changes in the field. Captain Anastasia stated that this request is straightforward. Without discussion, he made a motion to approve this request. Council members agreed 5-0. Mr. Koses stated that this item may be appealed through the close of business on August 14, 2019.
