HP20-08 <u>NOREEN KIMBALL</u> requesting a handicapped parking space at 24-26 Dale Street (Ward 2).

Approve as Amended (4-0, Danberg not voting). Approval of a 20-foot "No Parking" zone at 24-26 Dale Street.

TC36-08 <u>ALD. LENNON & SALVUCCI</u> on behalf of Esther Marchioni of 127 Linwood Avenue, requesting a discussion of parking restrictions on Linwood Avenue, specifically TPR-176, Linwood Avenue (1) Prohibited, all days: b) South side from Bridge Street to opposite Colonial Avenue (Ward 1).

Approve as Amended (5-0). No Parking permitted at any time on Linwood Avenue, north side, between Adams Street and Bridge Street. No parking restrictions on Linwood Avenue, south side, between Adams Street and Bridge Street.
