Zoning Reform - Provide sound legal advice to all affected departments on the second phase of zoning reform.

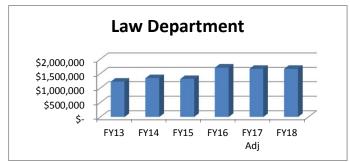
Recodification - Begin the process of recodification for new ordinance book.

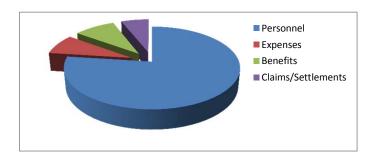
Public Records - Work with City Clerk's office on designating Records Access Officer (RAO) to purchase and train on new software system to monitor requests and responses.

Land Dispositions - Assist with former HHS building on Centre St; Crescent Street development; Austin Street development.





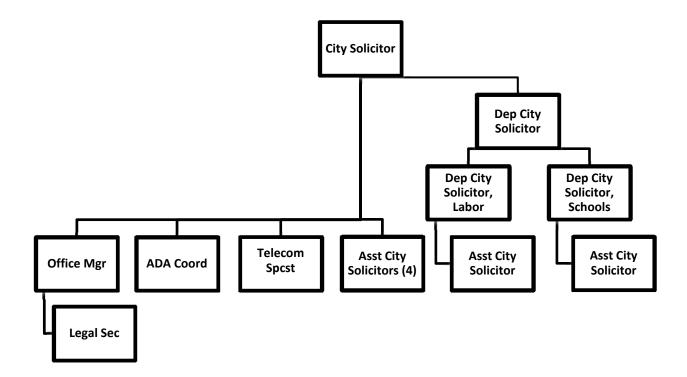
