Benefits - Ensure that veterans and their dependents who are receiving Chp115 benefits are paid in a timely manner; attend conferences and


Support Services - Work with the Senior Center to develop transportation that will help to get veterans to the VA Medical Centers; continue to work with veterans' organizations to help veterans.


