Combination devices must have voice and tone alert.

One Smoke Alarm is needed for up to 1,200 sq ft of area, per floor. Additional Smoke alarms needed BEYOND 1200 sq ft (1200-2200=2) (2200-3200=3)

**Addition or Modification of a bedroom, or renovation >1/3 assessed value of the home.

ie: Home built 1975, added a bedroom in 2006, would have to be brought to "8/27/97-07" Code

As of Decemeber 1 2016, all Pre 1975 Smoke Detectors must have 10 year sealed, non-rechargeable, non-replaceable Battery
