<u>Project</u>. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation will present 75% design plans and give an update on the anticipated construction start date. This project proposes roadway reconstruction and transportation safety improvements including new pavement, sidewalks, traffic signals, crosswalks, bicycle lanes and storm water management.
