  <u>DIRECTOR OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT</u> requesting amendments to the City of Newton Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 30, as needed to add a definition of "recreational marijuana establishment" and to create a temporary moratorium on the use of land, buildings and structures for recreational marijuana establishments in the City of Newton in order to allow the City adequate time to complete a planning process to consider in what districts and under what conditions recreational marijuana establishments will be allowed.

  COUNCILORS CROSSLEY AND HESS-MAHAN proposing to amend Sections 3.4,1, 4.4.1, 5.1.4, 6.2.7, 6.2.14, and 8.3 of the Newton Zoning Ordinance Chapter 30 to update the definition of lodging house; to set requirements and standards, including parking standards, for properties containing a lodging house; to allow lodging houses by special permit as a use above the ground floor in business and mixed use districts; and to delete or otherwise amend definition of "single-room occupancy dwelling, single-person occupancy dwelling" use to incorporate it into lodging house use and clarify that it is a type of accommodation within a lodging house.
