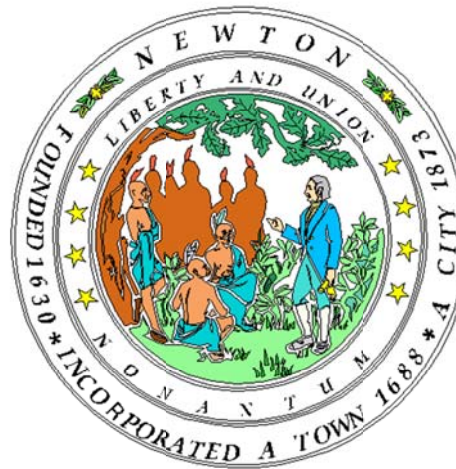

Building footprints and road edge-of-pavement originally from Boston Edison (based on 1991 aerial photos); Newton staff have updated buildings from subdivision plans and orthophotography. Thematic data (eg. Land Use) are from the Assessor's CAMA data base. Planimetric coordinates are based on the State Plane Coordinate System, Massachusetts Mainland Zone and North American Datum, 1983
