- Seems to be popular for holiday gatherings
- City can partner with site to share police alerts
- Site is self-managed and self-regulated, in rare cases company can block users
- Neighborhoods are limited to 3000 households
- Current Highlands map is split between north and south, Area Council would want the map be set to current service area
- Local businesses can join as individuals
- Businesses would benefit from hearing about local events perhaps more than advertising
- Area Council will consider benefits
