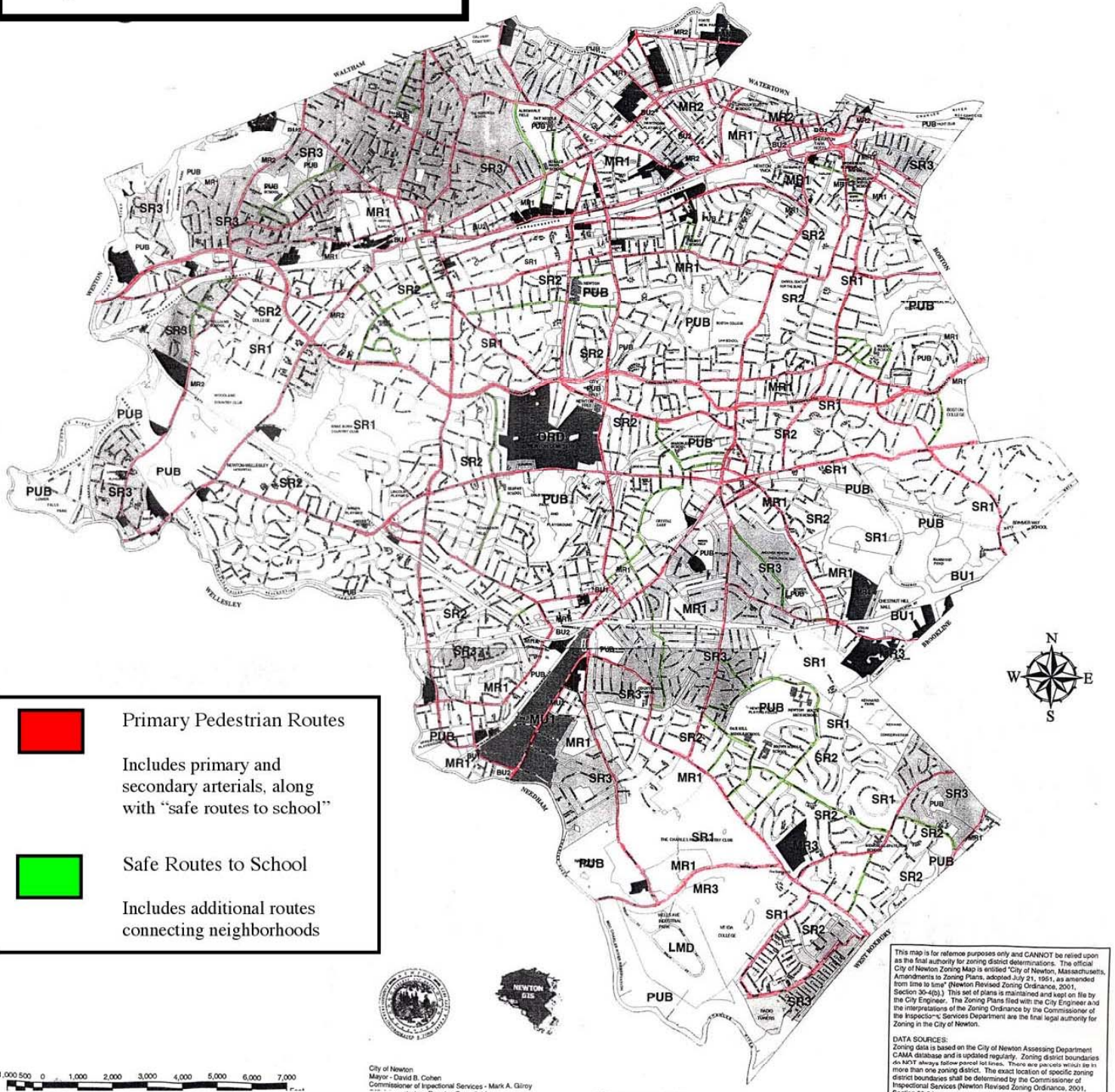


Primary Pedestrian Routes City of Newton

The official City of Newton Zoning Map is entitled "City of Newton, Massachusetts, Amendments to Zoning Plans, adopted July 21, 1951, as amended from time to time" (Newton Revised Zoning Ordinance, 2001, Section 30-4(b)). This set of plans is maintained and kept on file by the City Engineer. The Zoning Plans filed with the City Engineer and the Interpretations of the Zoning Ordinance by the Commissioner of Inspectional Services Department are the final legal authority for Zoning in the City of Newton.

DATA SOURCES:
 Zoning data is based on the City of Newton Assessing Department CAMA database and is updated regularly. Zoning district boundaries do NOT always follow parcel lot lines. There are parcels which lie in more than one zoning district. The exact location of specific zoning district boundaries shall be determined by the Commissioner of Inspectional Services (Newton Revised Zoning Ordinance, 2001, Section 30-3.)
