Morning Meeting: Campers meet with a small group of similar-aged friends, and one consistent staff member. This is an opportunity to form connections with a group, play quick games, share their thoughts and opinions, preview the day and ask questions. This meeting happens at the same time every day.

Choice Blocks: 45-minute live group sessions with a staff member that focus on one of three categories of activity; movement, games or arts and crafts. Movement activities include yoga, Zumba, dance, physical fitness and challenges. The Games Block could include Jeopardy, Family Feud and shorter game medleys. The Arts and Crafts Block could include activities like guided lessons focused on drawing, origami and making collages.

Closing Circle: The end of each day will include an opportunity to gather virtually as a whole-camp, preview the next day, meet in small groups for sharing or games and say good-bye.

Special Events: Special Events are held on Wednesday and Friday afternoons and may include special presenters, virtual visits from experts or performers.

Independent Recreation Activities Grid: The activity grid provides daily suggested activities and challenges that campers and their families can complete together offline. Some activities may include scavenger hunts, read alouds, building challenges, collection challenges that get you outside, art projects and more.
