The testimony from the public session on May 4, our own research, and the data that we have received from the Collins Center reflect that it is unusual for a charter to contain an article focused on planning. Indeed, items outlined as part of our own current charter in Article 7 have been superseded by the Act of 1975, Chapter 705 legislation. (refer to annotated article).

A charter review uncovers municipal issues and concerns, but all problems cannot and should not be expected to be resolved through the charter. It is likely that some of the points raised through our discussion will not result in changes to the charter, but instead will be considered for inclusion as part of our charter review report or the updated charter's transitional provisions.
