Our Camp Fair is scheduled for Sunday January 26th (snow date February 2nd) from 12:00 – 4:00 pm in the cafeteria at Newton North High School. We hope you can join us to see all of the programs we are offering in 2020 and enjoy some fun entertainment.

Our **ONLINE REGISTRATION** for camps will begin the Wednesday after the Camp Fair at www.newtonmarec.com. This is a new registration site that we started using in September of 2019 so if you haven't been to that site you will have to create an account to register.

Our camps will have staggered start times for online registration. Please see the attached flyer for information about registering online and start times for registration. Please go online to familiarize yourself with our online registration system and to create a family account if you haven't done so already.

Many of our camps will fill quickly. If you don't get in to all of the weeks you are interested in please be sure to add your child to the online waiting list. We often get cancellations and are able to get people in.

We have several camps and programs for youth of all ages. Included is a flyer with many of our different programs so you can see what programs are offered, what age groups they are for, what dates the programs run, locations, and costs. Newton Parks, Recreation and Culture Online Registration Information for Summer Camps - 2020

Online registration for Newton Parks and Recreation camps will begin on the **Wednesday** after the Camp Fair. Some camps will fill quickly, so please plan ahead. To find out more about our programs check out our website at www.newtonma.gov/gov/parks and click on camps.

Online registration is available at www.newtonmarec.com

- Please note that this is a different registration system than last summer so everyone will need to create a new account if they haven't already done so.
- Your main account needs to be created by an adult 18 years of age or older. You can then add additional family members in your account.
- The system will not allow you to create multiple accounts for the same person.
- Please be sure to accurately list your child's birthdate and grade. Some of our programs have age or grade restrictions and you won't be able to register if your child isn't the correct age/grade. If you make a mistake, please call us and we can help you fix that.
- Please make note of the username you create for your account if you are not using your email address as your username. Some people forget their username and then have trouble logging in.

We highly recommend that everyone do a practice registration to familiarize yourself with the new system before online registration for the camps opens. Go to www.newtonmarec.com and log into your account. Once logged in, click on the register button then Summer Camps then Practice Registration and you will be able to practice registering without being charged. Please pay attention to the member you are registering. If you need to change the family member, just click on the Change Member button.

Some of our programs require a \$30.00 minimum payment per week, some require payment in full. The Vacation Camps and many of the Specialty Programs require payment in full. If you want to make only the minimum payment, please be sure to change the amount you wish to pay when making your payment, otherwise you will be charged the full amount due.

We will have staggered registration start times for our programs to make registration easier. Please note that if you are registering for camps that have different registration start times you will have to do multiple checkouts because camps have a time limit for staying in your cart.

Recreation staff will be available on the day of online registration until 8:30 pm at 617-796-1500 in case you need assistance. Staff will then be available during normal office hours (M - F 8:30 am - 5:00 pm). We **WILL NOT** accept registrations or payments over the phone. Scholarships are available for those that qualify and applications are available on line or in our office.

Helpful Hints for Online Registration

Online registration is available at www.newtonmarec.com

Here are some helpful hints to try to make registration easier:

- 1. We accept Visa or Mastercard.
- 2. Set up a family account before registration opens. This will make registration go faster.
- 3. Familiarize yourself with the layout of the online registration system before registration opens. For Summer Camps, click on the Program icon (or Register tab then Programs) and in the drop down menu under the Programs heading select summer camps. This will give you a list of all of our summer programs.
- 4. Be sure to register the correct person. When you click on a program to register, there is a green section on the left hand side of the program you are registering for that says the person's name. If that is not the correct person, just click the change member button and you can select the correct person. If the person is not the correct age or grade, it will say incorrect age or grade and you will not be able to register that person for that program.
- 5. Click on all of the weeks you are interested in registering for before checking out for that program. Once an activity is in your shopping cart it will stay there for a set amount of time until you check out. If you have multiple kids that you are registering, register all of them and then do one check out. Please note, if you are registering for camps that have different registration start times (5:30, 6:30, etc), you will need to do multiple check outs because the items will not stay in your cart for that long. This system is much more user friendly than our previous system, but please take the time to practice and explore the online registration to make the night of camp registration go more smoothly.
- 6. DON'T waste time signing up for extended day for programs that have a separate add extended day option. Register for the standard day and then if you need extended day, you can add that later. Some camps fill up fast and if you spend time adding extended day you may miss out on getting into a week that you wanted. Please Note: With the Vacation Camps, Specialty Camps at Peirce School, and some other camps, you would need to register for either the standard day or the extended day option because there is not an add extended day option.
- 7. If you only want to pay the minimum payment for a program, and not the full payment, be sure to enter the amount that you want to pay, otherwise you will be charged the full amount. Some camps require a \$30.00 non refundable deposit per week, others like the vacation camps and specialty camps requires payment in full.
- 8. If something fills, make sure you add your child to the waiting list. If you don't make it in right away, space usually opens up around the March 15th cancellation deadline and we are usually able to get some people from the waiting list in. Please note: If you are on the waiting list and sign up at a different camp, please remember that each camp requires a non refundable deposit when you register. You may lose your deposit if you cancel.
- 9. If you've never registered for one of our programs before, or would like to practice registering, click on Summer Camps then Practice Registration and you will be able to practice registering for programs without being charged.
