

INFORMATION FOR REGISTRATION AND ATTENDING CAMP

Centre Acres offers seven one-week sessions at the Newton Centre Playground from July 6 to August 21, 2020.

Choose one or all of the weeks offered. A \$30.00 per week non-refundable deposit is required with the registration.

Children are grouped by grade. There is one counselor for every 5 - 8 campers.

Campers should attend camp dressed in comfortable clothing, sneakers and socks; bringing a bathing suit and towel each day. A water bottle, lunch and snacks must be brought from home. All children receive a Centre Acres T-shirt.

Registration for camp is online only. For information about scholarships, please call 617-796-1500.

Centre Acres follows the requirements of the Massachusetts Department of Health and the Local Health Department.

Centre Acres is held at the Jeanette West Recreation Centre on Tyler Terrace in Newton Centre. This historic building has a gym, indoor space for quiet activities, and bathrooms. Centre Acres also uses space inside of Mason Rice School, playgrounds and fields at Mason Rice and Newton Centre and Crystal Lake.
