

## Important Information

The City of Newton has offered summer day camp programs since 1982 when the first four-week pilot program was held at the Albemarle Playground/ Horace Mann School. The popularity of this initial program led to the formation of many others like it.

In 2020, T-ville Trails will offer seven one week sessions between July 6th and August 21st. Campers may register for any number of weeks.

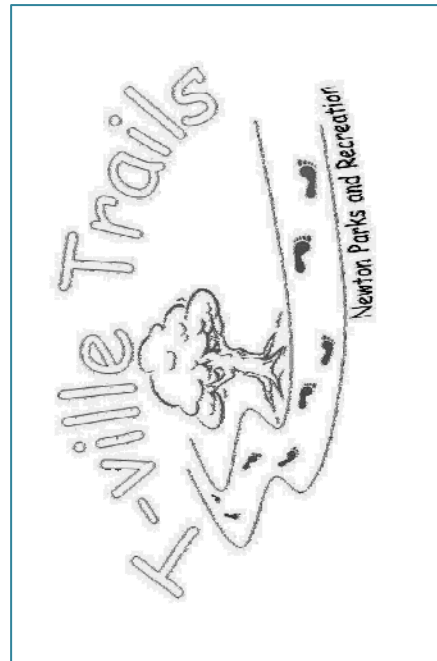
We offer an extended day program (for an additional fee) before and after camp for the convenience of camp families.

All children will receive a T-ville Trails T-shirt. Campers should come to camp dressed in comfortable, appropriate clothing including sneakers and socks. While there is no swimming at T-ville Trails, campers should still bring a bathing suit and towel each day for water play, and flip-flops or water shoes are suggested. Lunch and snack should be brought from home.

Registration begins online on the Wednesday after the camp fair for Newton residents and March 1<sup>st</sup> for non residents and continues until the program fills. ## Location and Facilities

T-ville Trails Summer Program will be held at the Bowen School located at 280 Cypress St in Newton Centre. The area has plenty of outdoor space and fresh air for a day camp program. There are playing fields and a playground for outdoor use. The school building provides ample space for indoor play, arts and crafts, and other inside activities

## Ages

T-ville Trails is suitable for children enrolled in **Kindergarten** through **6<sup>th</sup> grade** in the fall. Children entering Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will be in a separate space and doing different activities than the children entering 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The camp serves the residents of Newton and many nearby communities.

## Dates

T-ville Trails will run from July 6<sup>th</sup> through August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 Participants may register for any of the 7 weeks. Registration begins January 29<sup>th</sup> for Newton residents, and March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 for non- residents, and continues until the program fills.

## Staff

The strength of the program lies in our caring, qualified, enthusiastic, and responsible camp staff. A team of carefully screened high school and college students are paired with motivated professionals to provide the skills and energy needed to ensure the success and enjoyment of each camper. Staff is trained in First Aid and CPR. The staff and the program meet the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Camping standards and the Newton Health Department licenses the program. Parents may request, in writing, copies of any and all camp policies.



## Special Events

In 2020 T-Ville Trails will have a **daily** Special Event and will involve the entire camp. Special events may include carnivals, dress up days, animal shows, puppet shows and other demonstrations or activities based on the theme of the week.



## Activities

Campers will participate in a variety of activities each day. T-ville Trails offers three different activity choices during each activity period for each group. Campers will be able to choose what activity they want to participate in. A variety of activities will be offered including:
