

Off-Leash Area Working Group Friday, September 13, 2013 City Hall, Room 202 Meeting Minutes

- 1. Off-Leash Specialist Update J. Roberts- absent- No Report
- 2. Thompsonville Playground Proposal
 - Buzz Dunker of NSLL/NELL was present. Ms. Schein reviewed the off-leash recreation proposal
 for Thompsonville Playground. The area would be fenced. Alderman Albright and Mr. McIntyre
 previously met with the principal of Bowen School. The Principal requested the off-leash area be
 as far back as possible.
 - Mr. Dunker did not see a problem having the off-leash area at Thompsonville Playground as long as it is a fenced area and is located as far back as possible; the little league uses both fields.
 - Commissioner DeRubeis suggested inviting Mr. Tresca, owner of the condos abutting Thompsonville Playground, to the next meeting.
- 3. Jennifer Steel -Senior Environmental Planner
 - Commissioner DeRubeis introduced Ms. Steel, the new Environmental Planner for the City and provided an overview of the off-leash program for Ms. Steel. Commissioner DeRubeis is hoping to open up a discussion with the Conservation Commission regarding off-leash areas and conservation land.
 - Ms. Steel provided her past experience and stated she likes to be clear and defined in her communication.
 - Ms. Schein asked if Ms. Steel has worked in towns with off-leash areas. Ms. Steel stated she has
 had some exposure to the off-leash program in Andover. Ms. Schein asked if the program
 worked, Ms. Steel replied it was controversial in establishment, especially about fencing the area,
 but once established the off-leash area became part of the culture.
