 - There will be no fee for the program. Donations may be accepted for the offleash area program.
 - The program is described as a "refresher course on basic training techniques and off-leash area etiquette"
 - The pilot program will be offered to off-leash medallion holders. If there is a demand the group will discuss opening the program to others.
 - The Law Department must review the proposal.
