

## Off-Leash Area Working Group Friday, April 27, 2012 9:30 a.m., Room 202 Meeting Minutes

## May 21<sup>st</sup> P & R Commission Presentation

- Commissioner DeRubeis stated the Sports Leagues and Ward Alderman have been notified of the Public Hearing next week after the April 23<sup>rd</sup> Commission meeting. Signs have been posted at each site notifying the park users of the public hearing and notification will be sent out to abutters.
- ✓ Mr. McIntyre recommended the group be prepared to clarify misinformation.
- Ms. Schein recommended posting the answer to typical questions to the webpage along with the details of each site.
- ✓ Ralph Ranalli, of Newton Girls Soccer commented the stakeholders should have been invited prior to the proposal being brought forward. An off-leash area is not a good use of the area. Newton Youth Soccer and Newton Girls Soccer invest a lot of money into Weeks Field; this is the premier site for soccer. Soccer fields are harder to come by. The Soccer Leagues are supportive of the idea of off-leash areas but not at Weeks Fields.
- ✓ Alderman Albright explained the Off-leash Area Working Group has been meeting for at least two years and reports to the P & R Commission on a monthly basis. All meetings are public and all information is public.
- ✓ Mr. McIntyre asked if the concern is the condition of the fields. Mr. Ranalli said yes. Mr. McIntyre asked if the league would object to a part of Weeks Field being used as an off-leash area. If the group & Mr. Ranalli looked at a map of Weeks Field maybe they could find a location for the off-leash area. Mr. Ranalli stated Weeks Field should not be used as an off-leash area; the league would help find a different location for the off-leash area. Mr. McIntyre commented OLAWG has looked at all of the green space in Newton and there is not a lot of land available.
- Commissioner DeRubeis invited NYS & NGS to attend the next OLAWG meeting for further discussion.
