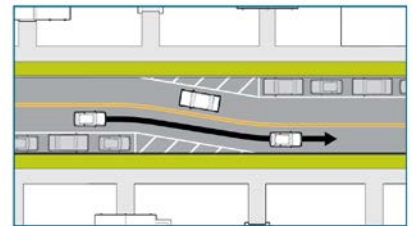
Overview The City of Newton is working on a proposal to change the pavement marking striping on Washington Street between St James Street and the Brighton border.

Project goals

- Decrease vehicle speeds
- Decrease likelihood of crashes
- Increase safety and comfort for all users

Using paint and signage, the project will

- Create a lateral shift in travel lanes
- Stripe narrower travel lanes
- Add crosswalks
- Add bike lanes
- Consolidate parking on one side of road (alternates)
