That in accordance with the recommendations of the Community Preservation Committee, through its Chairman, Andrew Stern; the Board of Aldermen Committee on Community Preservation, through its Chairman, Alderman Stephen Linsky; and the Finance Committee through its Chairman, Alderman Paul Coletti: the sum of Three Hundred and Twenty Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$320,550) is hereby appropriated from Community Preservation Fund Community Housing Reserve, to be expended under the direction and control of the Director of Planning and Development for purposes of funding the Accessory Apartment Incentive Program (AAIP) to create three new, code-compliant accessory apartments, as detailed in the CPC Recommendation (dated January 13, 2006) and CPC Recommendation Revised (dated January 31, 2006).
