That in accordance with the recommendations of the Community Preservation Committee, through its Chairman, Jeffrey Sacks; the Board of Aldermen Ad Hoc Community Preservation Committee, through its Chairman, Alderman Amy Sangiolo; and the Finance Committee through its Chairman, Alderman Paul Coletti: the sum of One Hundred Eighty Eight Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Seven Dollars (\$188,277) is hereby appropriated and transferred from the Community Preservation Historic Preservation Reserve, to be expended under the direction and control of the Director of Parks and Recreation in consultation with the Executive Director of the Jackson Homestead for purposes of funding costs for phase one (years 1 and 2) of the *Master Plan for Newton's Historic Burying Grounds* as detailed in Attachment C of the application (dated 1 November 2002).
