#09-18 Jewish Community Housing for the Elderly III, Inc., an affiliate of Jewish Community Housing for the Elderly, Inc., applying to the Zoning Board of Appeals of the City of Newton, pursuant to General Laws, Chapter 40B, Section 20 through 23, as amended, for the issuance of a Comprehensive Permit authorizing the applicant to construct sixty-nine (69) rental units (of which 60 units will be affordable at a range of incomes) and up to 3,300 square feet of clinic space on land located at 160 and 160R Stanton Avenue in Newton, Massachusetts. The property at 160 Stanton Avenue is located in a Multi-Residence 3 District and the property at 160R Stanton Avenue is located in a Public Use District.
