LANDSCAPE TREATMENT PLAN PRINCIPLES
CURRENTLY, THE THREE AREAS OF THE PARKS ARE CUT OFF FROM EACH OTHER, MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO CONNECT THE THREE PARTS OF THE PARKS.

MAINTAIN THE HISTORIC CHARACTER OF FARLOW PARK FROM FURTHER ENCROACHMENTS. THE PERIOD OF SIGNIFICANCE FOR FARLOW PARK IS WHEN IT WAS ORIGINALLY DESIGNED IN 1885.

PRESERVE AND PROTECT THE MATURE TREES IN THE PARKS, ESPECIALLY IN THE ORIGINAL FARLOW PARK. IN THE NEXT PHASE OF DESIGN, A TREE PLAN SHOULD BE ESTABLISHED AND NEW PLANTINGS SHOULD BE MADE THAT WERE PLANTED DURING THE PERIOD OF SIGNIFICANCE. THE SPECIMEN TREES IN THE PARKS SHOULD BE PROTECTED, REMOVED FROM FOOT TRAFFIC AND PRUNED IF NEEDED.

THE HISTORIC GRANITE CURB AND ENTRY MARKERS SHOULD BE PRESERVED AND THE HISTORIC ENTRANCES RESTORED WHEN POSSIBLE AUGMENT WITH HARDY PERENNIAL PLANTING.

THE INSTALLATION OF LOW ORNAMENTAL FENCE AND BLACK CHAIN LINK FENCING SHOULD BE USED WHERE POSSIBLE TO PROMOTE THE HISTORIC CHARACTER OF THE PARKS.

ENHANCE THE HISTORIC CHARACTER BY MAKING THE SITE FURNITURE CONSISTENT WITH THE FARLOW PARK FURNITURE.

DETERMINE A MEMORIAL POLICY FOR BOTH PARKS. ARE HISTORIC PARKS AN APPROPRIATE LOCATION FOR MEMORIALS.
