Unaccepted items that cannot be recycled must be removed by the resident from the Resource Recovery Center. Decisions of the volunteers and DPW Staff are final. Only Newton residents may drop off items.

Categories of acceptable items include:

Unacceptable Items include:

Building materials (drywall, pipes, etc.)	Light fixtures that are hard-wired
Children's car seats	Linens (unless new in package)
Curtains and curtain rods (unless new in package)	Plate glass mirrors– frameless
Construction materials	Pressed wood/particle board furniture
Cosmetics, personal care items	Rugs
Cribs	Sinks/toilets & seats
Cushions, pillows, stuffed animals	TVs & monitors

ORANGE OVERFLOW BAGS

To manage **occasional overflow trash**, you can purchase 33-gallon orange overflow bags at many Newton retailers (visit newtonma.gov/bluecart for locations). These are the only acceptable bags for extra trash collection in Newton.

BULKY ITEM PICK UP

Curbside collection of oversized items is available for a \$20 fee per item. Requests may be submitted online at: www.newtonma.gov/billpay. Payments for bulky waste pickup requests received by 10am on Friday will be picked up the following week on your trash day.

- Couches
- Chairs
- Carpeting (bundled/rolled, 4ft or less, less than 50lbs)
- Wood (bundled, less than 4ft long, less than 50lbs)
- Wood furniture

APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS,

METAL ITEMS, MATTRESSES & BOX SPRINGS

Optional curbside collection of large appliances, electronics and scrap metal items is available for a \$25 fee per item, \$60 fee per mattress/box spring. Requests may be submitted online at: www.newtonma.gov/billpay.

TVs/monitors cost \$25 per item and mattresses/box springs cost \$35 per item for drop off. Proof of payment must be presented to the attendant at drop off. Pay online at: www.newtonma.gov/billpay.
