

Construction & Demolition Debris (C&D waste)

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) amended the State Waste Bans (310 CMR 19.017) to add certain construction and demolition materials -- asphalt pavement, brick, concrete, metal, wood (treated and untreated), and clean gypsum wallboard to the list of items prohibited from disposal, transfer for disposal, or contracting for disposal. These items are no longer collected as trash and must be recycled by contracting a private hauler.

Increasing recycling and other diversions of C&D materials helps support development of in-state processing businesses and preserves valuable, limited disposal capacity in the Commonwealth. For more information on the Waste Bans, visit [MassDEP](#).

What does this mean for Newton Residents?

To be in compliance with the Waste Bans, Waste Management (WM), Newton's curbside trash collector, will not pick up any banned materials (asphalt, brick, concrete, metal, gypsum). To dispose of these materials, please contact a private hauler. See below for listings.

Although per City Ordinance (Chapter 11-4), the City can charge for bulky waste, WM will collect very small quantities of household demolition material (tile, flooring, drywall, etc.) when done by a homeowner. This material must be in compliance with City trash regulations: **place into blue trash carts or purchase orange overflow trash bags**, which must weigh less than 50 lbs.
