That in accordance with the recommendations of the Community Preservation Committee, through its Chairman, Andrew Stern; the Board of Aldermen Committee on Community Preservation, through its Chairman, Alderman Stephen Linsky; and the Finance Committee through its Chairman, Alderman Paul Coletti: the sum of Fifty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$55,700) is hereby appropriated and transferred from the Undesignated Fund Balance of the Community Preservation Fund, to be expended under the direction and control of the Commissioner of Public Buildings in consultation with the Library Director for purposes of funding the rehabilitation of the Newton Corner Branch Library as detailed in the application (dated 1 November 2002, with subsequent revisions dated 3 February 2003, and 24 August 2005).
