ORDERED:

That in accordance with the recommendations of the Community Preservation Committee, through its Chairman, Jeffrey Sacks; the Board of Aldermen Ad Hoc Community Preservation Committee, through its Chairman, Alderman Amy Sangiolo; and the Finance Committee through its Chairman, Alderman Paul Coletti: the sum of Twenty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighteen Dollars (\$23,718) is hereby appropriated and transferred from the Community Preservation Unreserved Funds, to be expended under the direction and control of the School Committee for purposes of funding a portion of the costs for creating an outdoor classroom at Memorial-Spaulding elementary school, as detailed in the application budget (submitted on 1 November 2002), but not including costs for the proposed statue, playground safety surfacing (under the statue), or curriculum support.




