## **Age-Friendly Domains**

The World Health Organization's Global Network of Age-Friendly Cities and Communities has identified eight domains of livability that influence the quality of life of older adults.

The domains are also used as a framework and starting point by the U.S.-based towns, cities and counties that belong to the AARP Network of Age-Friendly Communities

The following are the specific domains that are the focus of Newton's effort:

- Arts & Culture: Learning and skill-building, Integration into Health Care & Therapies, Expression, Self-Reflection & Socialization \*
- 2. Civic Participation & Employment: Volunteering Options, Employment Options, Accessibility, Leadership on Boards/Councils, Input on Policies & Planning
- 3. **Communication & Information**: Regular & Reliable Distribution, Universal Systems (written, broadcast, telephone), Coordinated Listings & Access ("one-stop"), Language, Computers and the Internet
- 4. **Community Support and Health Services**: Accessibility, Range of Services Type (primary care, behavior health, specialists) Range of Services Location (home care, outpatient, hospital, rehabilitation, Volunteer and Advocate Support, Emergency Planning)
- 5. **Educational Opportunity**: Access to Lectures, Classes & Explorations, Older adults engaged as community resources as tutors, mentors, and teachers\*
- 6. Housing: Affordability, Essential Services, Design, Modifications, Maintenance
- 7. **Outdoor Spaces & Buildings**: Environment, Green Spaces & Walkways, Outdoor Seating, Pavements, Roads, Traffic, Cycle and Walking Paths, Safety, Clustered Services, Buildings, Public Toilets
- 8. Respect & Social Inclusion: Respectful & Inclusive Settings, Public Images of Aging, Economic Support, Public Education
- 9. **Social Participation**: Accessibility & Affordability of Events & Activities, Facilities & Setting, Broad Promotion & Awareness
- 10.**Transportation:** Affordability, Age-friendly Vehicles, Specialized services, Safety & Comfort, Destinations, Reliability, Parking, Roads, Taxis, Driving Competence
- This domain was added by Newton to the City's planning. The AARP has designated the other eight domains that are recommended for all member of the network to use.
